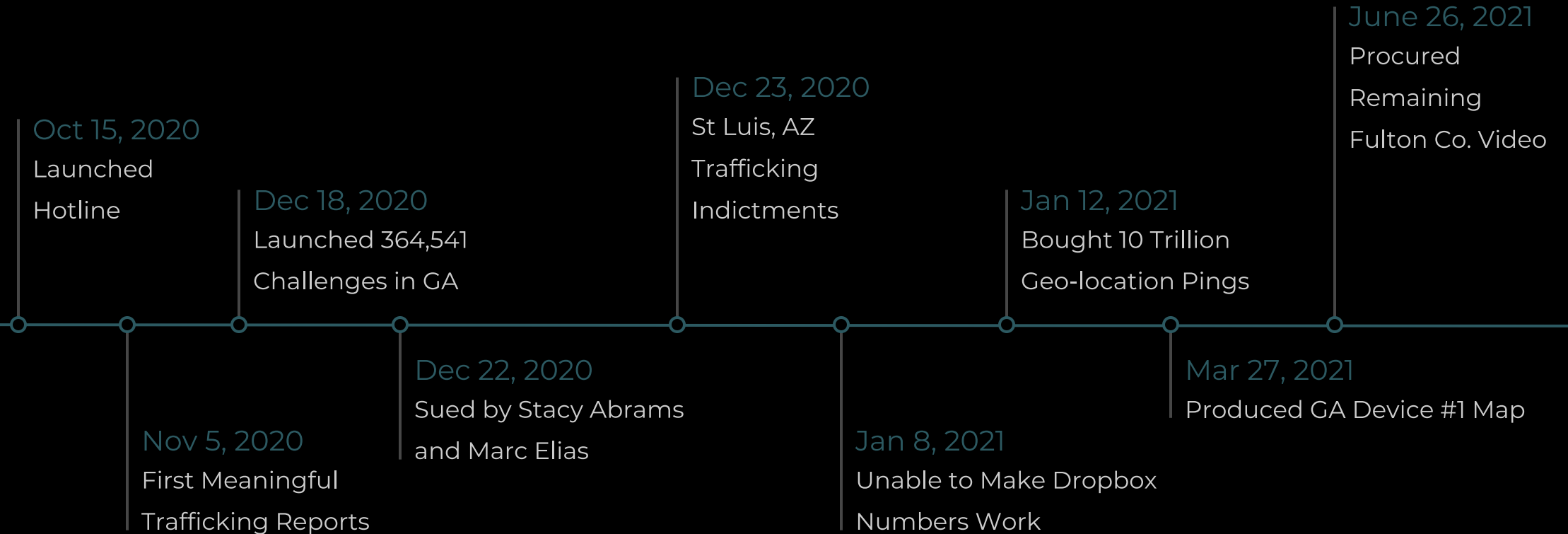

Study Criteria: Device tracked at 4 or more NGO's and 10 or more locations

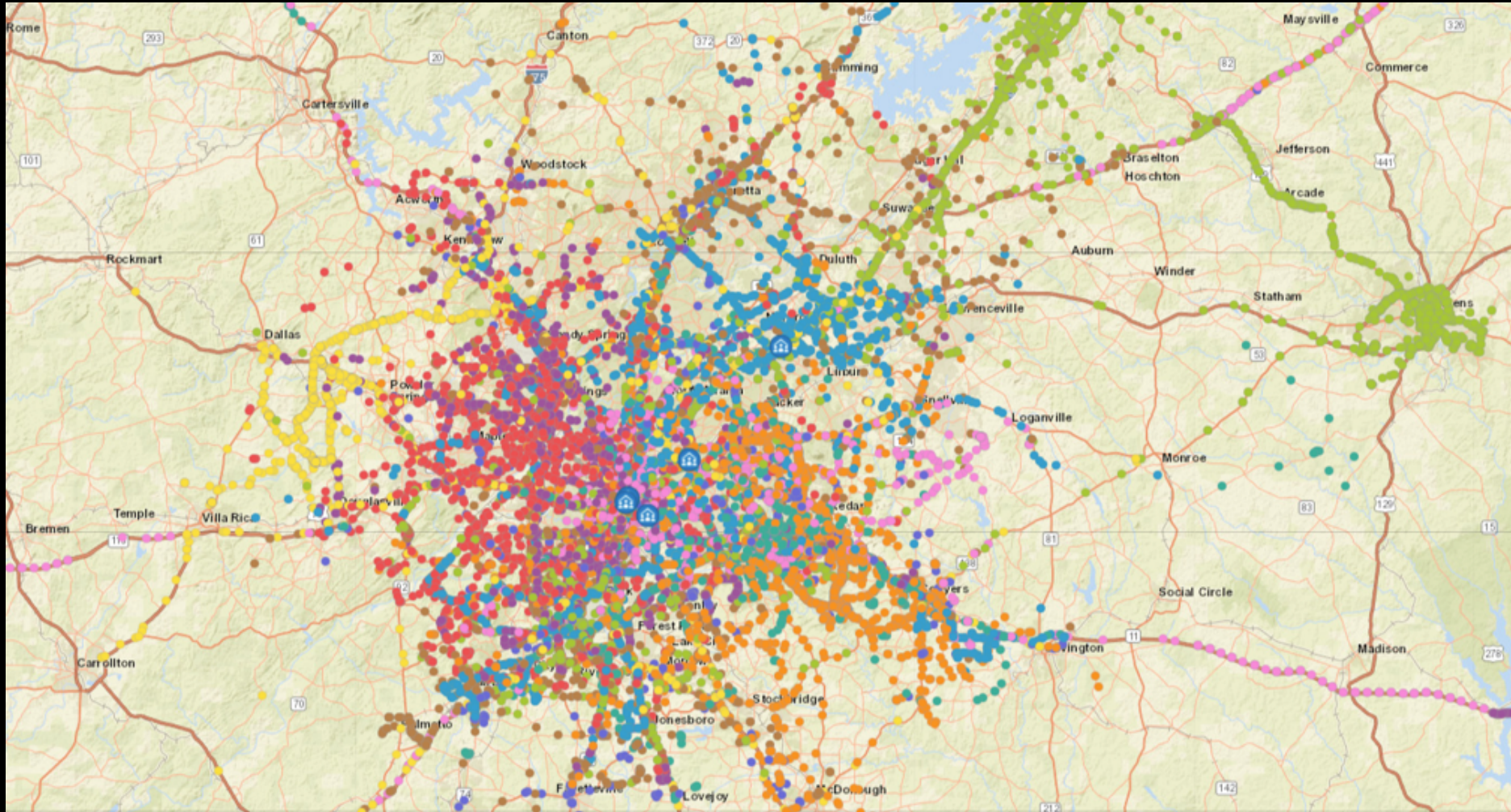

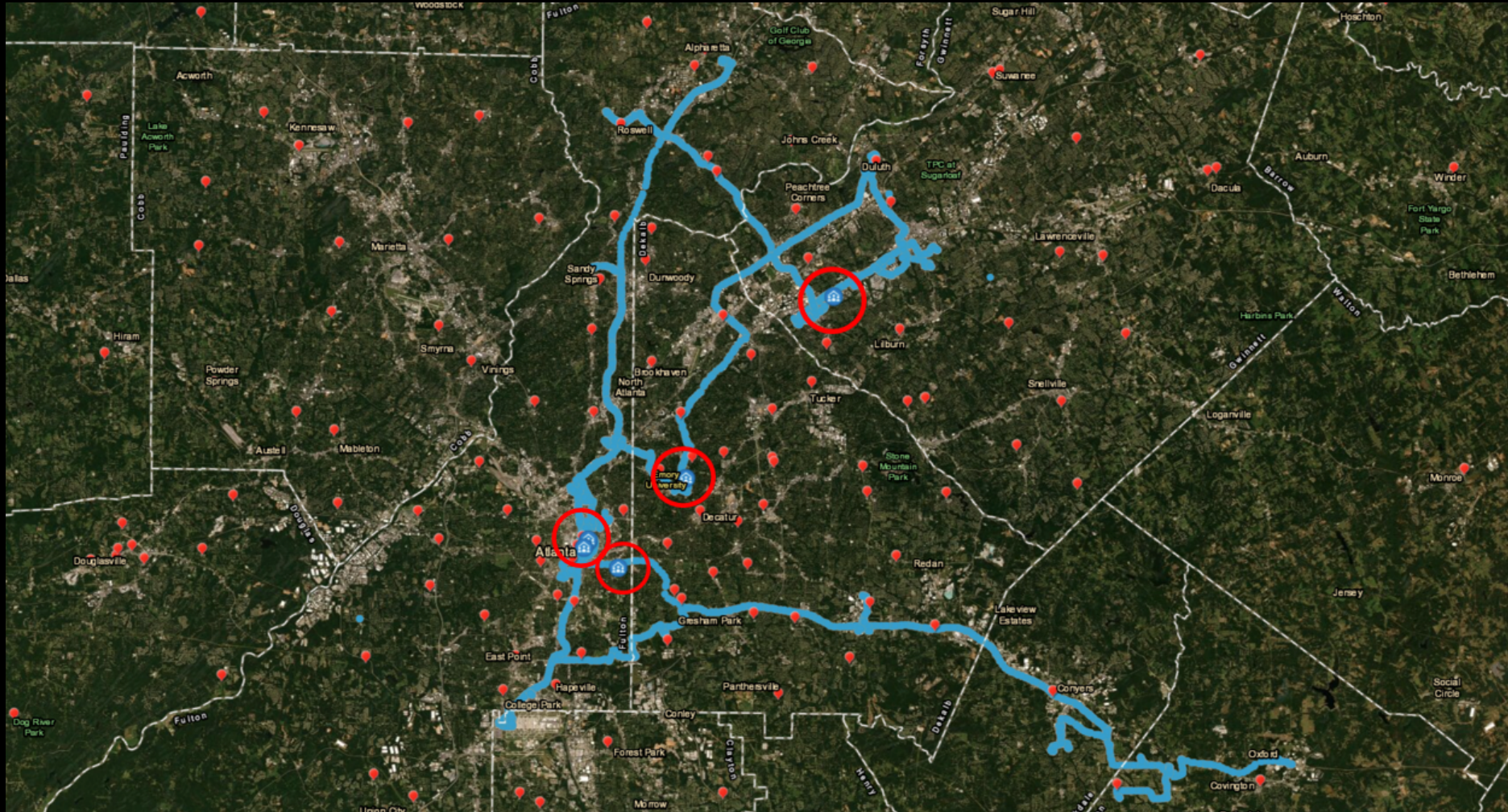

One Device. One Day. Five Stash Houses. Twenty-Eight Drop Boxes. Six Counties.

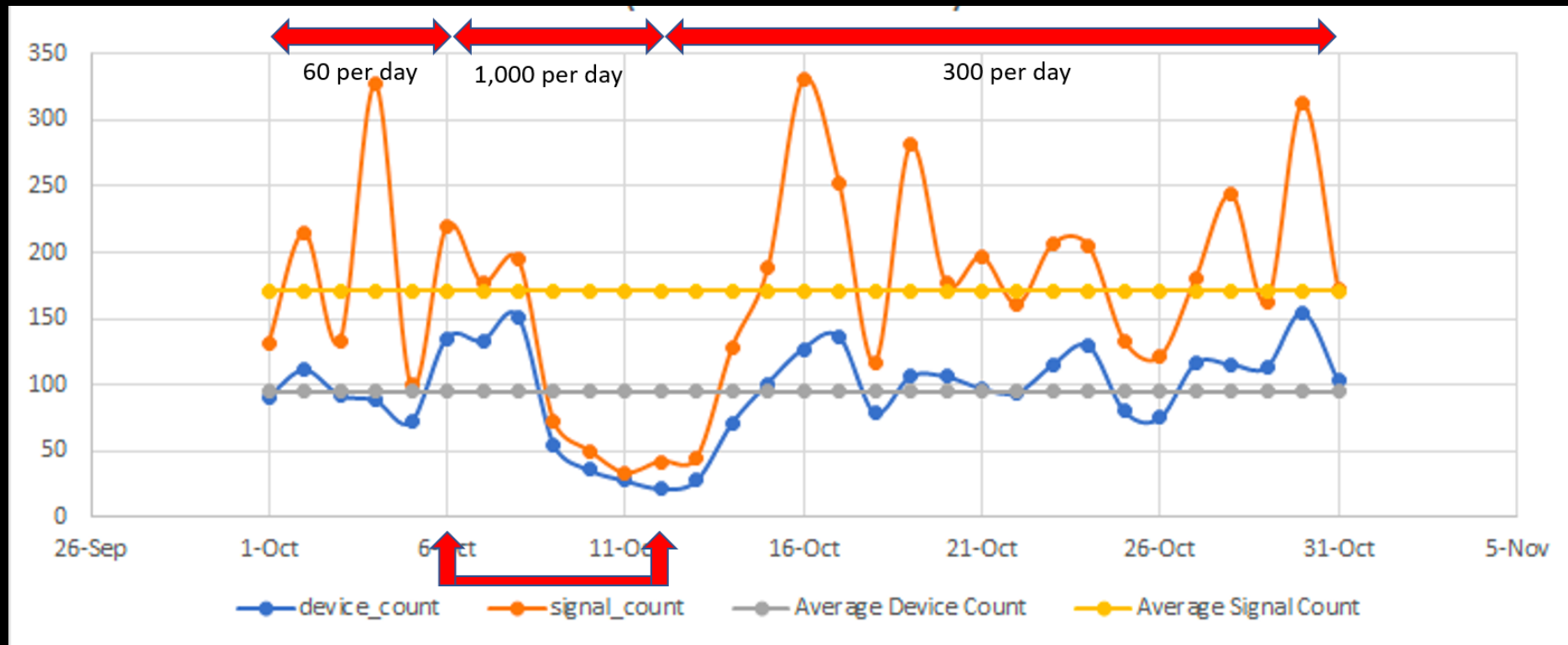

Device and Signal count | 100 foot buffer

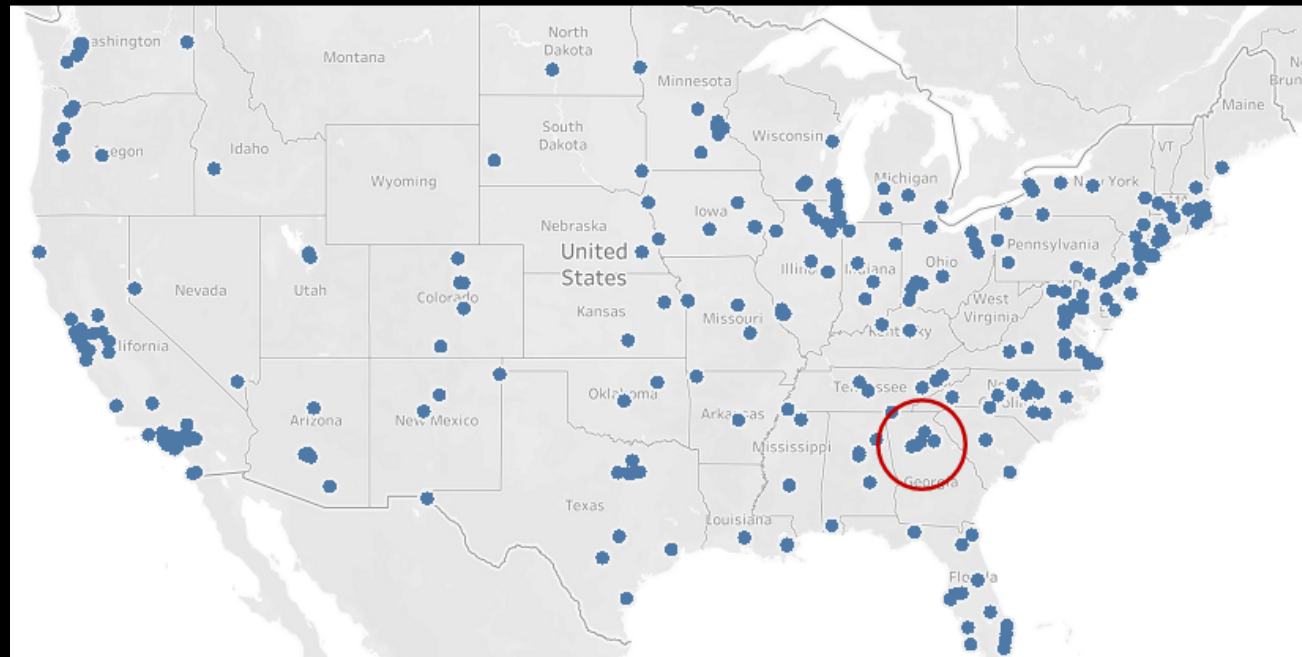
Gwinnett Voter Registration and Elections Building

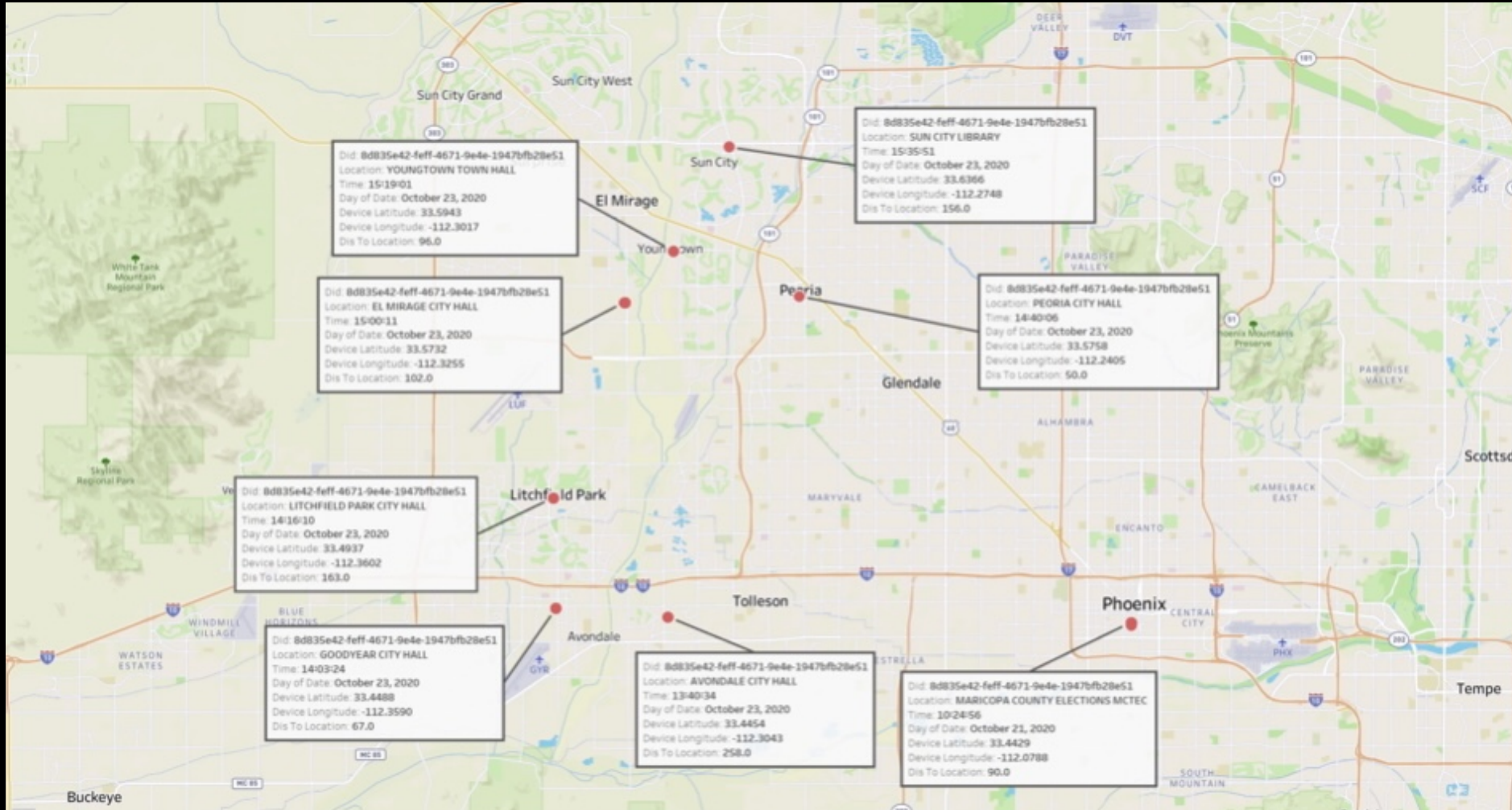
Eyes on Arizona

Study Criteria: Device tracked at 2 or more NGO's and 5 or more voting locations

Sample Arizona Findings
